Group Objectives:

- [] Increase Sensory Integration with play based therapy objectives
- [] Foster the ongoing development of peer interaction with sensory activities
- [] Offer participants the necessary tools and strategies to initiate positive relationships with a variety of sensory activities

Description

Are you looking for a summer camp for your child that has fun and interactive classes involving sensory play with gross motor and fine motor activities? Finding age-appropriate gross motor and sensory activities for your children, ages 3-7, has never been so easy. This six week, interactive class focuses on a specific sensory system each week and incorporates them all into sensory play activities. Learn how you and your child can experience these fun ideas at home. Parents receive information about implementing sensory activities at home. Camp will include peer interaction that involves sensory play activities focusing on each sensory system (Visual, Auditory, Touch, Taste/Smell, Body Position, and Movement). This camp is recommended for children who are sensory seekers or sensory avoiders for one or more of the sensory systems. The camp will include a variety of play schemes and obstacle courses to include all sensory activities and it will use peer models to encourage the child to interact with a variety of activities.

Format

Group participants will meet once weekly for 60 minutes. For greater benefit to each participant, parent/guardian participation is mandatory for the last 5 to 10 minutes of each session to meet with the group leader for discussion and review of handouts.
